The Brain Bank Committee provides path to postmortem brain research for neuroscientists. The researchers can apply to the chairperson of the committee for accessibility of the postmortem brain tissues of their interest.

Three essential conditions are required for the postmortem brain research: funding capability, IRB approval and understanding of dignity of death.

The Brain Bank Committee of the Japanese Society of Neuropathology provides an opportunity for postmortem brain research by neuroscientists. Researchers may apply to the chairperson of the Committee for access to postmortem brain tissues. The chairperson evaluates all applications and determines if an application is eligible for review by the committee members. After reviewing an eligible application, any member of the Committee wishing to collaborate with the researcher may contact the chairperson, who will then contact the researcher about a possible collaboration.

Three conditions are required by the Committee for postmortem brain research: 1) funding capability, 2) IRB approval, and 3) demonstration of an understanding of the dignity of death.
